Refreshing with citrus blossom, tangerine, melon, pear and mineral tones. Sourced from dry-farmed, own-rooted, 20 plus year Old Vines from neighboring, Mary's Peak Vineyard. Hand harvested and gently whole cluster pressed. Only 200 cases produced.

Mary's Peak Vineyard

Located just a mile and a half from Tyee Wine Cellars near Corvallis in Oregon's Willamette Valley, old vines of Pinot Gris were planted on their own roots in the 1980s. This vineyard is owned and managed by Rodger Kohnert and his wife who live and farm onsite. Tyee has a long term contract for old vine Gewürztraminer and occasionally Pinot gris from Mary's Peak Vineyard.
